




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BEHAVIOUR FOR LEARNING






ATTENDANCE MATTERS

BEING IN SCHOOL AT LEAST 95% OF THE TIME (BETWEEN 180 & 190 DAYS)








PUNCTUALITY MATTERS

EVERY SCHOOL DAY COUNTS BEING LATE ADDS UP TO A LOSS OF LEARNING

If you are 5 minutes late every day that adds up to 3 days lost each year. 15 minutes late is the same as being absent for 2 weeks per year.








The Homework Calendar
