Welcome back – Summer Term

I hope you had a restful Easter break and that you are looking forward to the new term and the promise of the lifting of some restrictions. Currently, school still operates with many safety measures in place, including regular Covid-19 testing by students and staff, the wearing of face coverings in school, one-way systems, heightened cleaning and ventilation arrangements and staggered break and lunchtimes. The hope is that as we progress through this term some aspects can begin to be relaxed. For example, extra-curricular clubs have started running this week. This week has seen the start of assemblies half year groups, the first time we have been able to hold 'face-to-face' assemblies for over 12 months. Some staff meetings are also taking place in person.

Lateral Flow Testing – reporting of results

Year 11 and 13 – arrangements for GCSE and A Level results

The Year 11 and 13 official leaving date will be **Friday 11th June 2021**.

Further guidance has been given to schools by the Joint Council for Qualifications (JCQ) on the procedures leading to awarding of GCSE and A Levels this summer. We have included the link to an overview for parents/carers with information about how grades will be awarded this summer. This includes a timeline of what is happening and when. It also describes the process of how schools will determine grades and when you will receive your results. Teachers will not be able to share overall grades with students and all grades are subject to approval by examination boards. Later in the term we will share with parents/carers the details for results day and enrolment into Brookfield Sixth form.

Expectations – uniform

Having high school uniform standards helps to promote Brookfield Community School's 'Commitment to Excellence' ethos.
