Parent Survey - January 2024

I hope you and your families are well as we approach the end of another very busy and productive term. For Year 11 and 13 students, attention is very much turned to forthcoming examinations. You should be aware of our 'Route to Exams' processes for both year groups, and upcoming Easter Revision school.

There will be an end of term letter next week, which will detail key dates and reminders for the summer term.

You will recall that earlier this term we distributed our online parent survey. The same survey was conducted at the same time by all schools across the Redhill Trust. I am very grateful for those who took the time to complete the survey. Almost 300 parents/carers completed the survey, which was extremely pleasing. The survey report is extensive and includes responses and breakdowns to all 42 questions, as well as any comments made. This detail is useful for the school in identifying the experience of families in relation to different aspects of school.

One of the most gratifying results was to Question 39: **On a scale from 1 to 10, how likely are you to recommend this school to other parents?** 87% of responses to this question were positive, which was well above the Trust average.

Included with this letter is the survey executive summary, which I hope you find useful. This shows Brookfield's results, along with how these compare to overall Redhill results. The Redhill average is the 'benchmark' shown in the attached document.

Results are being analysed to identify what parents feel is working well, and which areas are viewed less positively. At this stage, possible actions we will be taking following the survey results include:

- Tutor Review meetings introduced this year as a Redhill initiative. The format is likely to change next year to one which does not involve school closing early to accommodate these online meetings.
- Homework we are looking to introduce a new homework system from September.
- **Communication with parents** we are exploring a new platform for introduction from September which will streamline and simplify different communication methods.
